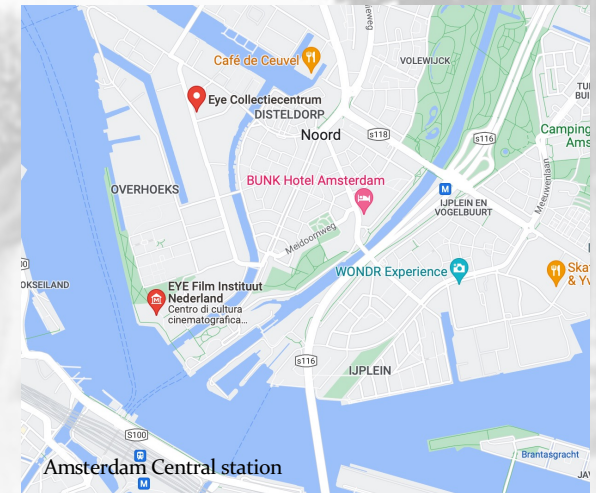

From Amsterdam Central Station:

Take the exit to IJzijde (IJ bank) to take a ferry in the direction of Buiksloterweg (line F3). The 24/7 ferry service is free and leaves every few minutes. The ferry ride takes approximately three minutes.
